Objective:

- The Food Services Assistant will serve mostly in an operations capacity in order to help provide nutritious and good tasting food for guests.
- They will be primarily responsible for preparing meals and kitchen sanitation.

Prerequisites:

- Exhibit a living, active and growing faith in Jesus Christ
- Be at least 17 years of age during the year of application
- Be physically fit, have good motor skills and be able to lift, bend, climb etc.
- Experience in cooking for large groups
- Adaptability to the demands and conditions in a camp setting
- Be clean and neat in appearance
- Be honest, responsible, industrious, and willing to follow directions
- Hold a Food Handler's Certificate from the NS Department of Agriculture
- Hold a minimum Emergency First Aid Certificate
- Hold a WHMIS Certificate
- Attend all applicable staff training events

Outline:

- Assist in the preparation, serving and clean-up of meals
- Maintain high standards of cleanliness in all areas of food service
- Help with keeping an accurate inventory of food and supplies
- Participate in all required staff activities
- Lead a weekly small group devotional in keeping with the Camp Peniel statement of faith
- Consistently take time for personal prayer and Scripture reading
