Objective:

- A Summer Camp Volunteer will serve in a programming or operations capacity in order to give direct care to guests, carry out camp programs, or aid in the carrying out of cleaning and maintenance duties.

Prerequisites:

- Be at least 13 years by July 1 of the year of application
- Be physically fit, organized, adaptable, responsible and show leadership qualities
- Be able to make mature and wise decisions

Outline:

- Be acquainted with and abide by camp policies and procedures
- Be able to work with their supervisor, direct report, and other staff members in executing their assigned tasks
- Be an active, engaged participant in activities, demonstrating team play
- Be adaptable for changing plans, on-the-spot activities and rainy days
- Consistently take time for personal prayer and Scripture reading
- Prepare for and carry out specific responsibilities and duties, including (but not limited to):
 - properly caring for guests, ensuring their health and safety
 - help with skill options and interest groups
 - help with campfires and camp-wide games
 - clean and set-up the lodge
 - do dishes and clean bathrooms
 - perform general maintenance tasks
